Guidelines for Poster Presentations

Dear Authors,

The presentations of the paper at the Conference should be content oriented and must follow the guidelines below. The poster presentation should be based on the final paper, as formulated to its last version considering the reviewers' comments.

Due to hybrid organization of the conference Poster Presenters are provided with two options:

- a. Participate in the ICTR virtual poster sessions, provide video presentations and participate to the Poster virtual sessions of the Conference (MANDATORY for all).
- b. Use the poster area of the conference (it will be organized based on the number of requests) which will require from you to print your poster and make physical poster presentation in specific slots of the program (OPTIONAL and in addition to the virtual poster sessions participation).

Please inform the organizing committee if you wish to have access to physical poster presentation space at the conference location.

1. Presentation Template

<u>Conference PowerPoint template</u> for presentation is available at the Congress website www.ictr.gr under the section "Announcements".

Please use this template only!

The language of presentations is English.

<u>Conference Poster Template</u> (for those who would like to use also option b above) is available at the Congress website <u>www.ictr.gr</u> under the section "Announcements". Please kindly note that the conference is not providing any printing support.

2. Duration of Poster presentations

In total 10 minutes have been allocated in each poster presentation at the ICTR program. This time includes presentation and time for answering to questions. In this context <u>the presentations</u> recorded on video must be strictly 5 minutes (3-5 slides).

Time for questions/answers will be available at the end of each virtual poster session.

3. Video recording instructions

In order to record your presentation, you may use any screen recording software of your choice. Kindly note that we would also like you to show your presence via webcam and to display your slides as you talk by sharing your screen.

While preparing your video presentation, keep in mind that the following technical guidelines must be met:

Duration: 5 minutes

Maximum file size: Up to 300 MB

Video format: MP4

Audio format: 48 KHz 96 bit (or better)

Minimum height: 720 pixels (HD)

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Video Aspect Ratio: 16:9

<u>To easily record a compatible video</u> from content displayed on your computer screen and voice recorded via the computer microphone while ensuring an optimal balance between the produced video/audio quality and the total file size, we suggest using the "<u>Zoom Client for Meetings</u>" software (note that a free Zoom account is required).

<u>To enable HD video</u> in the "<u>Zoom Client for Meetings</u>" software, please navigate to the "Video Settings" and tick the appropriate checkbox (Enable HD). To show your presence via webcam and to display your slides as you talk by sharing your screen by using the "<u>Zoom Client for Meetings</u>" software, you need to select "Video Settings" -> "Recording" and click on "Place video next to the shared screen in the recording". Then drag and drop the window with yourself to the right top side area of the screen, so that the Power Point slide area is not covered.

Kindly note that only .mp4 files of the video you have recorded will be accepted for upload to the ICTR workspace.

We do not provide individualized technical support to help authors create their video presentations.

4. Video & Presentation submission

The presentation video as well as the presentation file must be uploaded by the corresponding author by the **6**th **of August** at the ICTR workspace.

Corresponding authors may reach each paper's preconfigured folder in the ICTR workspace by following the unique (to the paper number) web link that will be sent to them by the Organising Committee. The presentation file has to be uploaded in the folder "PPT_PDF" and the video file has to be uploaded in the folder "VIDEO".
